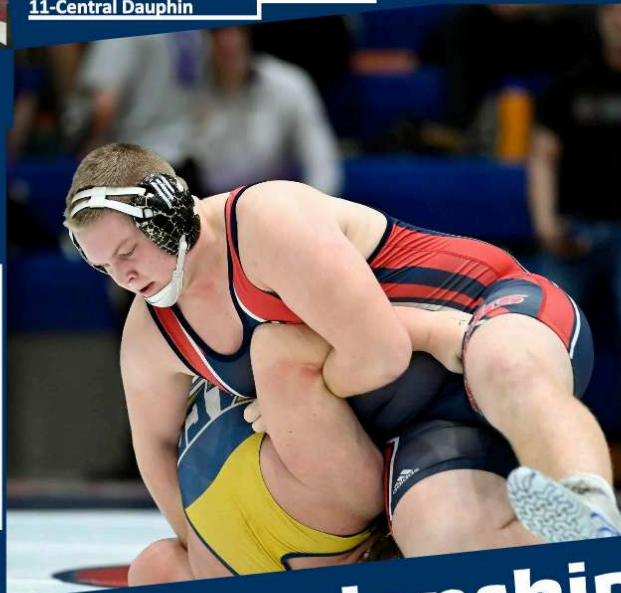
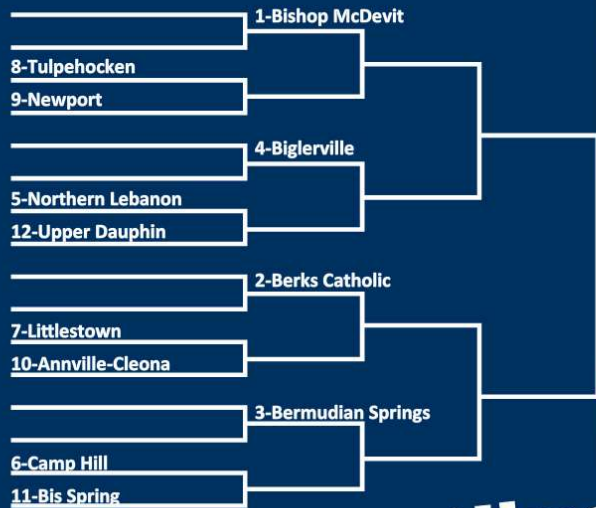

Thank you for supporting our student-athletes in District 3 and enjoy the matches!



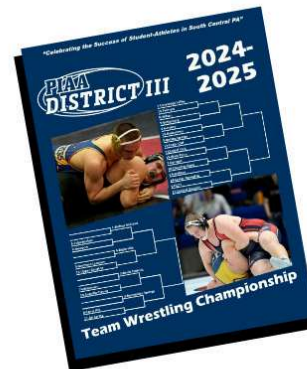

2024 DISTRICT III OFFICIAL PROGRAM

PIAA DISTRICT III

The state of Pennsylvania is divided in 12 geographic districts for PIAA administrative purposes. Each district has a district committee elected by member schools from within that District. Every committee elects a chairperson who becomes that District's representative on the PIAA Board of Directors. District III has an additional representative on the State Board based on the number of members schools. District I and District XII also have an additional representative; District VII has two additional representatives.

District III encompasses the counties of Adams, Berks, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry and York. Within this 10 county-area are 127 member senior high schools and 116 middle schools. These member schools elect their District Committee to oversee various interscholastic programs within the District. While the District Committee must follow all PIAA rules and regulations, each district has autonomy in administering athletic contests prior to the PIAA interdistrict level.

District III is home to the following leagues Berks County Interscholastic Athletic Association, Christian Commonwealth Athletic Conference, Lancaster-Lebanon League, Mid-Penn Conference, Tri-Valley League and York-Adams Interscholastic Athletic Association. A small number of schools retain independent status.

The voting rules of the District mandate that all leagues shall have at least one representative on the Committee as a voting member. These representatives are elected by the member schools at an Annual Meeting held each April. In addition, a representative from the Pennsylvania School Board Association, a male officials' representative, a female officials' representative, male and female parents' representatives and a girls athletics representative stand as voting members of the District III committee. There are 16 voting members plus 12 non-voting members on the Committee.

With the addition of girls individual wrestling for 2023-24, the District Committee develops, organizes and directs 27 District III championships (13 for boys, 14 for girls) in 16 different sports. Broken down by gender and class, the District conducts 71 team championships and 31 individual championships. Among the 31 individual championships, District III crowns 182 champions each year.

These championships are a prerequisite to qualification for PIAA championships. In the fall, these include boys and girls cross country, field hockey, boys and girls golf, football, boys and girls soccer, girls tennis and girls volleyball. In the winter, championships conducted are boys and girls basketball, boys and girls swimming & diving, boys teamwrestling, boys and girls individual wrestling and competitive spirit. While there is no PIAA championship for bowling, District III does conduct an individual championship for boys and girls bowling. The spring championships are baseball, boys and girls lacrosse, softball, boys and girls outdoor track and field, boys tennis and boys volleyball.

The cost of funding these championships comes primarily from the spectator ticket admission fees at District III playoff events. For sports where no admission fee is charged, schools pay a minimal entry fee per participant. Schools do not pay District dues. In years when the surplus is larger 50% of annual operating costs, the District will reimburse schools, either directly or by subsidizing their annual PIAA dues.

OUR MISSION

- ◆ Organize, develop and direct athletic programs that will promote the health and physical welfare of all participants, both male and female.
- ◆ Foster good sportsmanship and safeguard the educational values of interscholastic athletics.
- ◆ Develop and enforce rules adopted by the member schools that regulate interscholastic athletic competition.
- ◆ Organize and conduct a program of District III championship tournaments in various fields of athletic competition.

DISTRICT III WRESTLING ENROLLMENTS & CLASSIFICATIONS

The PIAA realigns classifications every two years. Classifications for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years are based on school enrollments of students in grades 9-11 during the 2023-24 school year. Schools must count their students in the school, plus any students in cyber/charter schools who live in a public school district.

ABOUT DISTRICT III POWER RANKING

The District III power ranking is a combination of the team’s weighted winning percentage (TWWP) and their opponents’ weighted winning percentage (OWWP). The ranking will be the sum of 55 percent of the team’s TWWP and 45 percent of the team’s OWWP. To be eligible for the tournament a team must have completed a minimum of eight (8) dual matches against PIAA opponents by the Power Ranking Deadline of Saturday, January 25, 2025. Team competitions wrestled to determine League Championships and not included in the school’s maximum number of regular season contests (22) are not included to determine the school’s final power ranking

CALCULATING TEAM WEIGHTED WINNING PERCENTAGE (TWWP)

The TWWP is based on the results of all games that a team plays against PIAA opponents. It values wins and losses by the classification of the opponent. The TWWP is calculated by dividing the WEIGHTED WIN VALUE by the sum of the WEIGHTED WIN VALUE and WEIGHTED LOSS VALUE.

All games against PIAA opponents will count in calculating a team’s TWWP. Games against NON- PIAA opponents are not considered for power ranking calculations.

CALCULATING OPPONENTS' WEIGHTED WINNING PERCENTAGE (OWWP)

The OWWP is calculated by totaling the WEIGHTED WIN VALUES and WEIGHTED LOSS VALUES of all of the team’s opponents; then, dividing the total of the WEIGHTED WIN VALUES by the sum of the totals of the WEIGHTED WIN VALUES and the WEIGHTED LOSS VALUES

Non-PIAA opponents will not be included in calculating the OWWP. If you play your opponent more than once, their totals will be included for each contest played.

CALCULATING POWER RANKING

The final power ranking is the sum of 55% of the TWWP and 45% of the OWWP. This number cannot be over 1.000. From the examples above:

$TWWP = 0.569892 * 0.55 = 0.313441$

$OWWP = 0.6244344 * 0.45 = 0.2809954$

- ◆ The **E. Jerry Brooks Academic Excellence Medals** are awarded to student-athletes who have a minimum GPA of 3.8, participated in at least two varsity sports their senior year, earned a minimum of three varsity letters during their high school career, possess good citizenship and sportsmanship, and are recommended by the school's coaches and athletic director.
- ◆ The **Fackler-Hower Sportsmanship Medals** are awarded to one senior female and one senior male student-athlete at each District III high school. The winners are selected for demonstrating the most sportsman-like qualities throughout the year. In addition, the student-athletes must possess good citizenship and sportsmanship.

Jerry Brooks, Charles "Pete" Fackler and Wendell Hower were long-time members of the District III Committee. Mr. Brooks served the Committee for 18 years, 15 as Chairman. He was also a 15-year member of the State Board of Directors where he served as President and acting PIAA Executive Director. After retiring as principal at Penn Manor High School in 1984, Jerry was named District III's first executive director.



Wendell Hower

Mr. Fackler was a District III committee member for 20 years, 10 as Chairman. He was also a member of the State Board for 10 years. After retiring as principal at Hershey High School, he spent several years at Harrisburg Christian and served as executive director of the Commonwealth Christian Athletic Conference. He continues to serve District III as program coordinator.

Mr. Hower was a member of the District III Committee for 21 years, serving as its Secretary for 16 years. He became executive director from 1998-2019 and also served on the State Board. A long-time educator, he retired after a 29-year tenure as principal at Manheim Township High School.

Sportsmanship - From A to Z

Accept and abide by the decisions of the Contest officials.

Be a good host to opponents and treat them as guests.

Cooperate with the coach, players and cheerleaders in trying to promote good sportsmanship

Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

Encourage your players to play hard and fair.

Follow the rules of the Contest at all times.

Good sportsmanship is the "Golden Rule".

Hold assemblies before a Contest to encourage students to display proper conduct.

Intervene to let others know that ethnic, disability and sexist jokes, racial or religious slurs, taunting, trash talk, and intimidating behavior will not be tolerated at events sponsored at your school.

Judgment calls on the part of officials are not subject to question or discussion

Know, understand and appreciate the rules of the Contest.

Lose without excuses; win without boasting.

Model language and behavior that is non-biased and is inclusive of individuals regardless of ethnicity, race, religion, sex or disability.

Never criticize players or coaches for the loss of the game.

Opposing coaches, participants, cheerleaders and fans must be respected at all times.

Provide opportunities for informing student and adult spectators of their responsibility to uphold the standards of sportsmanship.

Questioning of an official's call or making negative comments about an official is unacceptable behavior.

Recognize and show appreciation for an outstanding play.

Shake hands with opponents prior to the Contest and wish them good luck.

Teach sportsmanship and demand that your players be good sports.

Use cheerleaders, pep groups, and other student leaders to help develop a sportsmanship program at your school.

Victory celebrations and unscheduled game rallies should not be permitted at events sponsored at your school.

Work cooperatively with officials and other Contest personnel for an efficient Contest.
