**WEIGH IN:** (Note: Scales will be available at 3:10 p.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. on Saturday to check weights.) As per P.I.A.A. regulations, all weigh-ins will be by weight class. All team members who are being weighed in must be present when weigh-in period begins.

**ADVANCEMENT:** Into Regionals - District 1 (3); District 3 (6); District 11 (4); District 12 (3) = 16  
 Into States - Five (5) from Regional Tournament

**AWARDS:** A trophy will be awarded to the team champion of the Regional Tournament. Medals will be awarded to the first six (6) place winners. Awards will be presented on a two-weight class delay.

**PAIRINGS:** Sunday, February 22- will follow the same format as last year. See below.

**TICKET SALES:** All tickets will be sold online from [Hometown Ticketing](#) on the PIAA website or cash at the gate.

**INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS** (Session I, II, or III) **\$9.00 prior to the session date. \$10 the day of the session.**

**REGISTRATION:**

All wrestlers will have their hand stamped at weigh-ins.

Each school will receive passes for coaches, trainer, managers, school administrators on the following scale:

4 or more contestants = 5 passes

3 contestants = 4 passes

2 or less contestants = 3 passes

You will receive these passes at registration. No other passes will be accepted.

Coaches, pass holders, and contestants will enter the gymnasium entrance located in the front of the gymnasium.

**PARKING:** Please see the parking map below provided by Warwick HS (page 4)

**INJURIES:** If you have a wrestler who sustains an injury during the week prior and cannot compete, please contact Brad Keeney immediately. In addition, if you have a wrestler that may not compete, please contact the alternate wrestlers school so they may be available.

**STATE TOURNAMENT:** State information will be distributed and explained at coaches' meeting.

**STATE TICKETS:** Except for two (2) complimentary tickets for each school which qualifies one or more wrestlers for the State Tournament -- State tickets are not available at the Southeast Regional Tournament.

**LOCKER ROOMS:** Locker rooms will be available for **CHANGING and SHOWERING PURPOSES ONLY**. Student athletes should report directly back to their team area in the gym after use and take all their personal items and valuable with them. **PIAA and Warwick High School will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.**

**CONTESTANTS' and COACHES DECORUM: THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED !!**

All contestants must be dressed in school-issued uniforms and/or school-issued warm-ups while on the gymnasium floor and during awards presentations and photographs. Hats, sunglasses, cutoffs, altered clothing, or clothing displaying inappropriate advertisements, jewelry, and other cosmetic paraphernalia are prohibited while on the arena floor.

**WRESTLER STAGING AREA and WARM UP AREA:** Teams/wrestlers will stage in the auxiliary gymnasium. Warwick will also open their wrestling room for wrestlers to warm up if needed. **Wrestlers should use the wrestling room only when they are within 15 minutes of their upcoming bout while the tournament is running.**

**SPECTATOR AREAS:** Spectators should remain in the bleachers when in the gymnasiums. **No spectators are permitted to be on the floor with the teams/wrestlers within the competition area.**

NOTE: PIAA will not reimburse schools for lodging, meals, or transportation expenses.

**SEEDING FORMAT** Based on 24 bracket patterns from Seeded District Champions

1. The four District champions will be seeded on points based on the combination of:
  - A. **Winning Percentage** -- i.e., the number of victories divided by the total number of matches wrestled. A wrestler must have wrestled a minimum of 12 matches. **Eight points will be deducted for each match less than 12.** Winning percentage will be based on the record that a wrestler has at the end of the regular season (**do not use District Team or Individual Tournament results**).
  - B. **Prestige Points** -- i.e., a wrestler will be awarded points for his highest place finish in the previous year's State Tournament. The points awarded will be consistent in all three Districts.
2. The four District champions will be placed in the sixteen-man bracket on lines 1, 16, 8, and 9 respectfully.
3. The first and fourth place finishers from each District will be placed in the same half bracket, where applicable. The second and third place finishers from each District will be placed in the half bracket opposite the district champion. Samples of all brackets are attached.
4. The top four place finishers from any District cannot meet until the semi-final round.
5. One of twenty-four possible bracketing combinations will be used based on the seeding of the four District champions
